## John Calvin (1509-1564)

Although Martin Luther was the most influential individual of the Reformation period, John Calvin would soon assume the role of its intellectual giant. Perhaps no other figure in church history better exemplifies the vocation of "pastor-scholar" than Calvin. Initially trained in law, Calvin would feel a call to the ministry and would break away from the Roman Catholic Church in 1530. Persecutions in France would lead him to eventually become the resident pastor-scholar in Geneva where he enacted many reforms so as to see the richness of grace infiltrate civil society. Many from England would flock to Geneva to learn under Calvin. John Knox said of the work there, "It is the most perfect school of Christ that ever was on earth since the days of the Apostles." Calvin's scholarship would have him write a commentary on almost every book of the Bible in addition to numerous tracts. His monumental *Institutes of the Christian Religion* is still regarded as one of the most biblical and devotional works of theology of all time. Its themes of the sufficiency and majesty of the Word of God, the absolute sovereignty of God in all things, and the saving and sanctifying power of grace still resonate today. Calvin's pastoral care for the flock in Geneva is underestimated by many who have never read his letters.
