### Jonathan Edwards (1703-1758)

Regarded by many as the greatest pastor-theologian that North America has produced, Jonathan Edwards' gifts of writing and preaching are studied with wonderment. The literary prowess of Edwards is acknowledged even in our own time as his most famous sermon, *Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God*, is studied in English classes. That sermon is not a window into all his preaching, however, as he had many other sermons with titles such as *Heaven, a World of Love*. While the intellect of Edwards is to be lauded, his missionary endeavor to Native Americans is often overlooked. Along with George Whitfield, Edwards was an influential preacher and revivalist during the First Great Awakening. Edwards would dramatically preach the doctrines of grace, identifying with his Puritan heritage, as many encountered the majestic teaching of the sovereignty of God in salvation. Yet there were no theatrics in his preaching; he typically preached from a written manuscript, only occasionally looking up from it. But the utter seriousness and gravity of his person, combined with the integrity of his life, made for a most powerful witness. He was not without controversy in his pastoral tenure; standing for a principle against the popular desires of the people in the congregation caused him to leave the pastorate in Northampton, Massachusetts. While many in Edwards' day contended that bodily movements were the truest indication of Holy Spirit revival, Edwards sought to correct such notions in writing his famous work, *A Treatise Concerning Religious Affections*. To Edwards, both the mind and the heart played important roles as a sinner is encountered by grace, leading one's affections to the throne of the risen Christ. In spite of all that Edwards accomplished in his lifetime, his greatest legacy is found in his eleven children. From his children, over 400 descendants of Edwards have been traced, including fourteen college presidents, one hundred ministers, numerous lawyers and judges, and one Vice-President, Aaron Burr.
